

Written oath

- 1) Student visa holders cannot be absent for a reason of work, travel, or any other personal reasons. Attendance rate of at least 80% must be maintained.
- 2) Student visa holders cannot be absent from their class without a permission. Early leave or being late also need a permission from the school. Must explain the reason of your absence, early leave or being late to the school and let us understand your situation.
- 3) Our school has multinational and multicultural students, each with a variety of values, ways of thinking, and learning styles, and we must respect each of them while taking classes. Even if someone has a different way of thinking than you, you cannot criticize them or refuse to have a conversation with them.
- 4) It is necessary to understand and participate in class lessons that the class style is to engage in peer activities without bias in order to improve communication skills.
- 5) In Japan, there are only a few clinics and counseling rooms where foreigners can receive medical treatment, and they may be booked up several months in advance. You must understand that if you are unable to control your mental and physical condition and are frequently absent, leaving school early, or being late, this may result in a visa issue at the Immigration Bureau.
- 6) There is a final exam at the end of every semester. The passing score for the final exam is 60 points, regardless of the reason.
You cannot advance to the next grade unless you pass the exam.
If you fail, you will study at the same level the next semester.
Additionally, students must reach the N4 level upon graduation from our school. To do this, you must attend class and do your homework consistently.

1. Conditions for receiving a diploma

- ① More than 1 year enrollment
- ② Attendance rate of 80% or more
- ③ Passing CEFR A2 (JLPT N4) or higher levels in external exams such as TOPJ
- ④ Taking the final exam every semester until your graduation

Even if you have been enrolled for less than one year, you can receive a certificate by completing ②③④.

2. Taking external examinations such as TOPJ

- ① You will take the first TOPJ exam after 5 - 6 months of enrollment.
- ② Once you reach the CEFR A2 level, there will not be a problem.
If you do not pass CEFR A2, you will need to take it again until you pass the level.
- ③ If you failed to pass the level twice, you will need to take our school's JLPT N4 online course (1 month) outside of the class hours.
- ④ If you are absent from the N4 online course without a permission, there will be penalties.
- ⑤ If you are absent from the TOPJ exam without a permission, there will be penalties.

3. At our school, the part-time jobs we can introduce are very limited. In addition, without sufficient Japanese language ability, it is difficult to find a part-time job. Therefore, please be aware that students may not be able to start working immediately after enrollment, and make sure to prepare enough funds to support yourself even without part-time work.
